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#1077 Mini Carrot Stuffie - 2 Sizes

Makes: One Plump Carrot or Two Skinny Carrots

Finished size: 2.75" (7cm) carrot with 1.75" leaves (4.5cm) - 4.5" (11.5cm) total

Plump Carrot: 5.25" (13.3cm) circumference

Skinny Carrot: 3.25" (8.3cm) circumference

Seam Allowance: 1/4" (5mm) included

Materials:

Fabric: non-stretch fabric, such as woven cotton "Quilting Cotton", linen, canvas, or flannel. Use solid color fabric or fabric with a small non-directional design.

Amount: 6" x 6" (15.3cm) square of both colors.

Color Information: Use solid color fabric or fabric with a small design. Recolor as desired

- Carrots come in many colors, pick your favorite.
- Leaves: You will see both sides of the leaves, pick a fabric that has a green backside as well.

Stuffing: Poly-fill or Pillow stuffing

Ties: String, Cord or Ribbon.

Tools

- Rotary Cutter, Scissors, or a Cutting Machine, like a Cricut
- For Cricut Maker
 - Rotary Blade
 - Fabric Mat
- For Cutting Machines with a Fine Point Blade
 - Standard or Light Grip Mat
 - Freezer Paper for Bonding
- Typical Sewing Materials (pins, scissors, matching thread, iron, etc)



Prepare Fabric

1. Wash Fabric if desired
2. Press smooth

Hand Cutting Directions

1. Print patterns at 100% size. Check scale square in verify accurate printing.
 - This pattern is not very fussy. If it is not exactly to scale don't worry.
2. Cut Carrot and leaf patterns from corresponding fabric.
 - 2 carrot triangles makes 1 plump carrot or 2 skinny carrots.

Machine Cutting Directions

1. Cut fabrics down to a width that fits on your mat. (12" (30.5cm) for Cricut) Extra length can hang off the end of the mat. Or use a scrap of fabric larger than 6" x 6" (15.3cm)
2. Cricut Maker: Apply fabric to cutting mats and continue to Cricut Design Space Instructions
3. Cutting Machines, such as Cricut Explore series, with a fine point blade: You must bond the fabric to another material. I suggest freezer paper.
4. Cut two 6"x 6" (30.5cm) pieces of freezer paper and bond them to each fabric with a hot iron.
5. Place fabric on cutting mat paper side up.

Cricut Design Space Instructions

1. Download zip file
2. Un-zip
3. Open Cricut Design Space
4. New Project
5. Upload your selected project into design space
6. Add to Canvas
7. Follow directions on the SVG about checking the size and ungrouping.
8. Re-color pieces as desired.
9. Make-It
10. Check placement of pieces on the mats and adjust if needed.

11. Press Continue

12. Select Base Material

- Cricut Maker: Choose Calico
- Cricut Explore Choose Felt, Craft Bonded

13. Cut Materials

14. Design Space may change the mat order. Please check which mat is next, or select the mat you want to cut.

15. Unload and change mats as needed.

Assembly - One Plump Carrot

1. Assemble the Carrot body: Lay triangles on top of each other, right sides together. Sew along one edge. Press and open up flat
2. Assembly the leaves. Lay leaves on top of each other, right sides together. Sew along one edge. Press and open up flat.
3. Attach Leaves to Carrot Body. Pick one below
 - Place right sides together. Pin the curve and sew as per normal. OR
 - With pieces right side up, over lap leaves with the top of the carrot by about 1/4" or 1cm. Then pin or glue to hold, before sewing in place through all layers. The stitching line will show, but likely be hidden in the gathering later.
4. Fold carrot in half, right sides together to create a cone shape. Pin if desired
5. Sew from tip to leaves
6. Clip excess seam allowance at the point
7. Turn right side out, using a pin or chop stick to help turn the point.
8. With strong thread sew a gathering stitch along the color join.
9. Fill the Carrot with stuffing. Be sure to get stuffing down to the point.
10. Pull the gathering threads and tie off.
11. Decorate with ribbon or jute cord.



Assembly - Two Skinny Carrots

1. Attach Leaves to Carrot Body. Pick one below
 - Place right sides together. Pin the curve and sew as per normal. OR
 - With pieces right side up, overlap leaves with the top of the carrot by about 1/4" or 1cm. Then pin or glue to hold, before sewing in place through all layers. The stitching line will show, but likely be hidden in the gathering later.
2. Fold in half, right sides together to create a cone shape. Pin if desired
3. Sew from tip to leaves
4. Clip excess seam allowance at the point
5. Turn right side out, using a pin or chop stick to help turn the point.
6. With strong thread sew a gathering stitch along the color join.
7. Fill the Carrot with stuffing. Be sure to get stuffing down to the point.
8. Pull the gathering threads and tie off.
9. Decorate with ribbon or jute cord.
