A Global Dance Note: The practice of recording and teaching dances by writing down their 'steps' is a relatively new concept forged in Europe. Historically, cultures all over the world taught new generations to dance by demonstrating and verbally instructing them as new dancers learned how to move their bodies. As many of these dances were never intended to be written down, they may have no terminology for their specific phases or movements. In the interests of sharing some of these dances with modern audiences accustomed to verbiage from English Country Dancing and Italian Dance History, we will be using this vocabulary to describe the movements of dances that have existed for time out of mind. We are grateful for the knowledge we have and hope we are able to continue learning and teaching folk dances in ever more authentic methods.

## Tinikling Performance

Lead by Maestra Maria Beatriz la Mora Filipino folk dance done by dancing between rhythmic poles. A pair of drummers, plus the stick movements creates rhythm - Open, Close, Open; Open, Close, Open; Creating a $3 / 4$ rhythm. The basic premise is don't be caught between the sticks when the close on 2 . However it is not the goal to trap the dancers feet. If there are more than one pair playing, for example three lined up like railroad ties, there will always be a set of poles opening and closing.

The rhythm playing is reminiscent of horses hooves across the fields (dumka tek ka ka)The dance as is brought to mind in the description of the parts. Both are done like smoothly moving regal birds. All the figure are executed either on the toes, or at least with the spine as erect as possible and with very small steps executed so smoothly that one can imaging the dancers are either gliding across the water or soaring through the air.
